Reimagining India@2047

The Future Starts with YOU!







In 2047, India will celebrate 100 years of independence. The choices young people make today will shape the nation we become — just, fair, inclusive, and future-ready. As eduheros, you play a vital role in guiding them to dream bold, design big, and act now.

We invite you to use the **FIDS (Feel-Imagine-Do-Share)** process with your students to explore challenges in their community and create prototypes that move us closer to the India we all want to see in 2047.

Here's how it works in practice:



FEEL

Encourage students to notice a challenge in their community. For example: local traffic congestion near the school makes it unsafe for children to commute.



IMAGINE

Guide them to ask "why does this happen?" and talk to those involved. Perhaps there are no safe crossing zones, and parents' vehicles crowd the area during peak hours.



DO

Students design a quick but bold prototype. They could create a model of a smart pedestrian crossing, design an app that schedules pick-up times, or build a miniature traffic management system using sensors.



SHARE

Finally, they test the idea (even as a small-scale model), document the process, and share their story of change with the school and community.



FUTURE OF BELONGING & GOVERNANCE

A tomorrow where every voice counts, and technology makes life fairer for all.

- How might we use AI and digital tools to create governments that listen to everyone — free from caste, gender, or class bias?
- How might you design ways for every voice to be included in decisions at school or in your neighbourhood?
- How might tools like AI or digital
 platforms help create spaces that listen
 to everyone free from caste, gender, or
 class bias? Prototype a small step where
 young people's voices are heard and
 respected.



FUTURE OF LEARNING & WORK

A tomorrow where schools and skills prepare us for jobs that don't even exist yet.

- What makes learning joyful or stressful in your school?
- How might you make learning more creative and practical for the future?
- Try out a bold new way of learning or testing — start small, see how it works, and share what you discover with others.



FUTURE OF HEALTH & WELL-BEING

A tomorrow where health belongs to everyone.

- What health or hygiene challenges affect children and families around you?
- How might you make your school or neighbourhood a healthier place?
- Try out a bold idea to improve health or well-being — for example, a small campaign for handwashing, a mindfulness activity, or a mini fitness program. Test it on a small scale, see how it works, and share what you discover with others.



FUTURE OF HERITAGE & CULTURE

A tomorrow where tradition and technology go hand in hand.

- How might we keep tribal languages, folk songs, and local wisdom alive so that every child in 2047 can learn and enjoy them?
- What if children found new ways to celebrate old festivals, dances, and crafts — through stories, plays, murals, or even simple digital tools?
- How would you carry India's rich past into the future, while adding your own fresh ideas?



FUTURE OF SAFETY & PLANET

A tomorrow where people and nature are protected.

- What makes your environment unsafe (roads, water, air, climate events)?
- How might young people take the lead in making schools and neighbourhoods safer and greener?
- Prototype a step towards clean water, safe spaces, or protecting nature.



FUTURE OF YOUTH LEADERSHIP

A tomorrow led by courageous young people.

- Where do you feel young people's voices are missing today?
- How might young people take the lead in making fairer, kinder spaces?
- What bold step could YOU take today to start building that future?
